



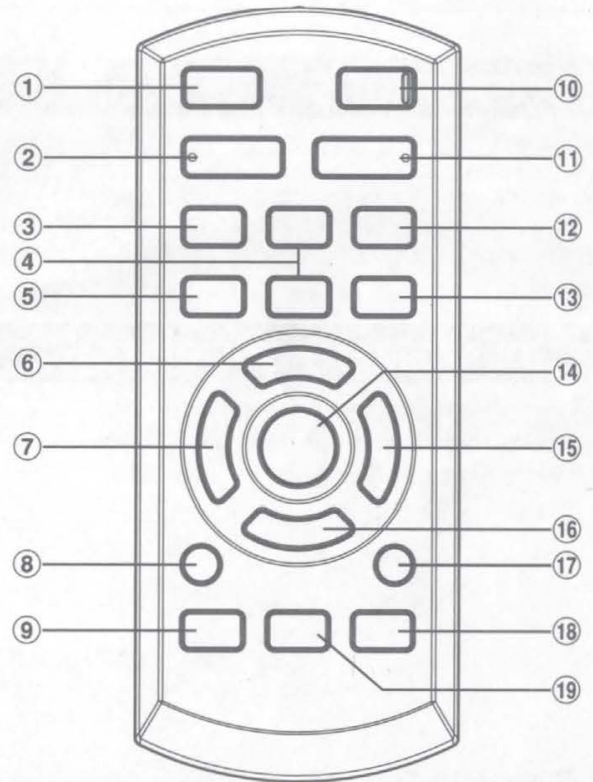

Owner's Manual Mode d'emploi

CONTROLS ON REMOTE CONTROL

- ① **Power Button**
Press the button to turn the power on/off.
- ② **Source Button**
Press to select the audio source.
- ③ **Volume Up Button**
Press the button to increase the volume level.
- ④ **Subwoofer Level Buttons**
Press '+' to increase and '-' to decrease the subwoofer level.
- ⑤ **Volume Down Button**
Press the button to decrease the volume level.
- ⑥ **▲ Button**
Radio Mode: Next Preset
USB/ MP3 Mode: Folder Up
Audio Processor Mode: Press this button to adjust the MODE that is called by pressing the AUDIO P. button.
- ⑦ **◀◀ Button**
Press to seek down a station in radio mode or down a track, chapter, etc., in other audio/visual sources.
- ⑧ **Repeat Button**
USB/ MP3 Mode: Press the button to repeat the current track.
- ⑨ **Voice Button**
Depending on the connected smartphone, press to recall Siri function or voice recognition mode.
- ⑩ **Mute Button**
Press to activate/deactivate the mute mode.
- ⑪ **Band Button**
Radio Mode: Toggle Band.
- ⑫ **Pick Up Button**
Press the button to accept an incoming phone call.



- ⑬ **Hang Up Button**
Press the button to reject an incoming phone call or to end a phone call.
- ⑭ **▶ / || Button**
Press the button to switch between the Play and Pause modes for USB/ MP3 playback.
- ⑮ **▶▶| Button**
Press to seek up a station in radio mode or up a track, chapter, etc., in other audio/visual sources.
- ⑯ **▼ Button**
Radio Mode: Previous Preset
USB/ MP3 Mode: Folder Down
Audio Processor Mode: Press this button to adjust the MODE that is called by pressing the AUDIO P. button.
- ⑰ **M.I.X. Button**
USB/ MP3 Mode: Random playback order of tracks.
- ⑱ **Audio Processor Button**
Each press of the button changes the external audio processor mode.
Press ▲ or ▼ button to perform setting / adjustment.*1

*1 For the operation of external audio processor, refer to the Owners Manual of the external audio processor you purchased.

- ⑲ **Defeat Button**
Press the button to toggle defeat on/off.

• Depending on the device you are using, you cannot operate or may need to operate differently some devices on the remote control.
For details, refer to the Owners Manual of the device you purchased.

HANDLING PRECAUTIONS

⚠ WARNING: Do not ingest battery, Chemical Burn Hazard.

The remote commander contains a coin/button cell battery. If the coin/button cell battery is swallowed, it can cause severe internal burns in just 2 hours and can lead to death. Keep new and used batteries away from children. If the battery compartment does not close securely, stop using the product and keep it away from children. If you think batteries may have been swallowed or placed inside any part of the body, seek immediate medical attention.

Do not drop or apply shock to the unit. It may be get permanently damaged.

Keep the unit away from water and moisture, direct sun and heat, and excessive dust.

Never use scouring pads, steel wool, abrasive powders or harsh chemical agents, such as lye solution, for cleaning.

Clean with a soft, lint-free cloth or cotton swab slightly dampened with a mild solution of detergent and water.

Do not operate this unit in a manner that could distract you from driving safely.

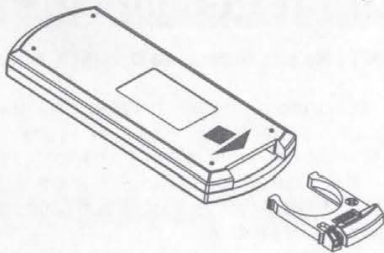

BATTERY REPLACEMENT

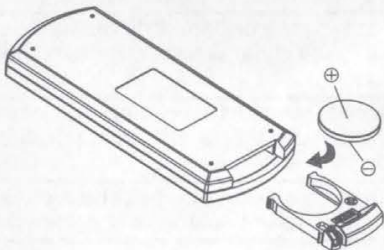
① Opening the battery tray

Release the hook and remove the battery tray.



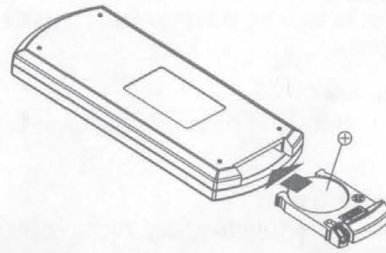
② Replacing the battery

Put the battery in the case observing the polarity as illustrated.



③ Close the battery tray

Push the tray as illustrated until a click is heard.



IN CASE OF DIFFICULTY

Problem	Cause	Solution
Remote Control Inoperative	Reverse placement of battery.	Place the battery correctly into its tray.
	Dead battery.	Replace the battery with a new one.
	Remote control not pointed toward the head unit.	Point the remote control directly toward your head unit.
